NOTICE

TREASURY MINUTE dated 26th March 1986

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 26th March 1986 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE A74)

(STRATHCLYDE REGION)

(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 1986

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order extending for a further one year restrictions to traffic on lengths of the London-Carlisle-Glasgow-Inverness Trunk Road (Route A74) in Strathclyde Region. To enable roadworks to be carried out on lengths of the said trunk road from the Dumfries and Galloway Regional Boundary to the end of Route A74 at its junction with the Draffan-Stonehouse Road (unclassified) at Blackwood, it will be necessary to restrict traffic from time to time by closures of one carriageway or one lane of a carriageway.

While such closures are in operation traffic will be confined to a single lane width, with or without opposing traffic on the adjacent lane. The Order will cover closures over the period up to 30th April 1987.

Intending users of the route with vehicles or loads exceeding 2.9 metres in width should, in addition to the normal notification procedure, confirm with the Strathclyde Police the suitability of the route on the particular day of the journey.
