As feveral Artificers and Manufadurers, Subjetts of Great Britain, have, from Time to Time, gone into Foreign Countries to exercife their feveral Callings, contrery to the Laws of thefe Kingdoms, the follow-ing Al/tracts of Ads of Parliavent of Their late Majeflies King George the First and Second, and of the theoret Meinley for the provide (1999) Hidghties Ang George the First and Second, and of His prefent Majefly, for preventing fuch Practices, are published, for the Information of all Perfons who may be ignorant of the Penaltics they may incur by Difobedience to them: And it will be obfrwed, that fuch Penalties likewife extend to those who are any ways concerned or inforumental in the Sending or Enticing Artificers or Manufacturers out of these kingdoms, or in the Frenetation of the Toole and Kingdoms, or in the Exportation of the Tools and Infiruments used by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufaqueers themfelves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27.

F any Periou fhall contract with, entice, or folicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brafs, or other Metal, Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer of Great Britain, to go iato Foreign Countries out of the King's Dominions, and shall be convicted thereof, upon Indictment or Informa. tion in any of the Courts at Weltminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter Seffions, he shall be fined any Sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for the first Offence, and shall be imprisoned Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Perfon having been once convicted shall offend again, he shall be fined at the Diferetion of the Court, and imprifoned Twelve Months, and till the Fine be paid.

If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Artificers, shall go into any Country out of His Majefty's Dominions, to exercise or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any fuch Foreign Country, exercifing any of the faid Trades, fhail not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minister, or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artificers shall be, or by any Perfon authorifed by fuch Ambaffador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from henceforth inhabit within this Realm ; fuch Perfons fhall be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor of Administrator, or of taking any Lands, &c. within this Kingdom, by Defcent, Devile, or Purchale, and fhall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majefty's Use, and shall be deemed Alien, and out of His Majefty's Protection.

Upon Complaint made, upon Oath, before any Juilice of Peace, that any Perfon is endeavouring to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted or is preparing to go out of His Majefty's Dominions, for the Purpoles aforefaid, fuch Justice may fend his Warrant to bring the Perfon complained of before him, or before fome other Juflice; and if it fhall appear by the Oath of One Witnefs, or by Confession, that he was guilty I of any of the faid Offences, fuch Juffice may bind
