*Copy of a Letter from Captain Mansfield, of His Majesty's Ship Minotaur, to Sir Evan Nepean, Bart. Dated at Sea, 30th May 1803.*

SIR,

I BEG Leave to acquaint you, for their Lordships' Information, that I this Evening saw the French Republican Frigate La Française safe off the Dodman, agreeably to Signal made by the Honorable Admiral Cornwallis. She was captured by His Majesty's Ship under my Command, on the 28th of May, in Company with His Majesty's Ship Thunderer, having chased from the Fleet, and during the Chase was joined by the Albion, which Ship had parted from the Fleet some Days before in thick Weather. The Prize proves to be the Republican French Frigate La Française, from Port-au-Prince Thirty-five Days, Captain Jurien. She is pierced for Twenty-eight Twelve-Pounders on her Main-Deck, and Sixteen Nine-Pounders on the Quarter-Deck and Forecastle, Ten of which were in her Hold, and had on board One Hundred and Eighty-seven Men.
