SIR,

P BEG Leave to acquaint you, for their Lordships' Information, that I this Evening faw the French Republican Frigate La Françaife fafe off the Dodman, agreeably to Signal made by the Honorable Admiral Cornwallis. She was captured by His Majefly's Ship under my Command, on the 28th of May, in Company with His Majefly's Ship Thunderer, hving chafed from the Fleet, and during the Chafe was joined by the Albion, which Ship the Chafe was joined by the Albion, which Ship thad parted from the Fleet fome Days before in thick Weather. The Prize proves to be the Re-publican French Frigate La Françaife, from Port-au-Prince Thirty-five Days, Captain Jurien. She is pierced for Twenty-eight Twelve-Pounders on her Main-Deck, and Sixteen Nine-Pounders on the Ouerter Deck and Forecaffle. Ten of which were Quarter-Deck and Forecastle, Ten of which were in her Hold, and had on board One Hundred and Eighty-feven Men.
