Copy of a Letter from Vice-Admiral Vashon, Commander in Chisf of His Majefly's Ships and Veffels at Leith, to the Hon. W. W. Pole, dated August 2, 1308.

SIR,

AM to beg you will be pleafed to lay before the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty the inclosed Letter which I have received from Captain Dix, of His Majelty's Sloop Cygnet, giving an Ac-count of the Capture of the Danish Privateer Brig. Chriftiana, mounting Fourteen Guns, with a Complement of Sixty Men; out Three Days from Chrifrtiana.

The Privateer has just anchored in Leith Roads. J. VASHON. 1 am, &c.

His Majefty's Sloop Cognet, at Sea, SIR, July 27, 1802. I BEG Leave to inform you, that, after a Chace of Nine Hours, I had the good Fortune to come up with and capture the Danish Brig Privateer Chriftiana, mounting Fourteen Gans, Twelve Twelve Pounder Carronades, and Two long Nines, manned with Sixty Mer; out Three Days from Chriftiana without having made any Captures. She is victualled and flored for One Month, and was pro-ceeding off the North End of Shetland for the Pur-pole of intercepting our homeward-bound Greenlandmen.

The Chriftiana was formerly an English Merchant Brig.
