IY Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty having ordered His Majesty's Ship Profelyte to be itationed off the Ifland of Anholt, to carry a floating Light for the Safety of the Convoys paff-ing or repailing, and the faid Ship being directed to take her Bearings as follows, viz. the Light-Houle on the Island to be brought to bear N. W. by N. by Compais, in Sixteen or Seventeen Fathoms Water, the outer End of the Knolun or Anholt Reef will then bear N. E. by N. by Compass, distant Five Miles; Notice thereof is hereby given, for the Information of the Matters and Pilots of His Majefty's Ships, and for the Benefit of Navigation in general. W. W.
