then prefented the Ribbon and Badge to the Sove- [ reign, and His Majefty put the fame over the Right Shoulder of the new Knight, who, being thus in-verted, had the Honour to kils the Sovereign's Hand, and withdrew.

Whereupon the Proceffion returned in the Order before oblerved.
