

But we have at the same time witnessed with exultation and thankfulness the wise and vigorous measures of your Royal Highness's Government, which, by a well-timed activity and firmness, have arrested the threatened mischief in its progress, and which, under the blessing of Providence, cannot fail to preserve to these countries the inestimable benefits of our unequalled Constitution.

We trust that the treasonable efforts which have been made for the subversion of that Constitution, will only tend to call forth a more ardent zeal for its support from all classes of the community; and for ourselves we beg leave to add, that no exertions shall be wanting in the discharge of our appropriate duties, for the furtherance of those principles of religious obligation and social duty, on which only the stability of the Throne and the happiness of the people can be securely built.

Graciously permit us, Sir, to lay at your Royal Highness's feet this expression of our sincere feelings, of our devoted attachment to the Religion and Constitution of our country, and of our unshaken loyalty to your Royal Highness, and to your illustrious House.
