Now, therefore, Her Myjesty, by and wifh the advice of Her Privy Council, doth, in pursuance and in exercise of the powers and anthority in Her vested by the aboveratatienned Acts, declare, that the ships of oll such forefign powers as have treatios of reciprocity with this country, and the cargoes imported or exported therein, shall be admitted, under the said Acts of Parliapent, on paying the like rates of duties and tolls a those charged on British vessels and their cargoes:
And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary directions herein accendingly.
