

An Act for authorising the sale of the Durham Junction Railway to the Newcastle and Darlington Junction Railway Company, and for enabling the said Company to make a station at Gateshead, with a bridge and approaches to connect the said last-mentioned railway with the town of Newcastle-upon-Tyne, and for other purposes.

An Act to amend an Act for maintaining the pier and harbour of Newquay, in the county of Cornwall, and to make certain tramroads in connection therewith.

An Act for regulating, maintaining, and improving the port of Padstow, in the county of Cornwall, and the navigable parts of the river Camel or Allen, in the same county.
