doms, in giving Us fo abfolute and figmal Vistories over the late R bels, who in contempt of the Laws of God and of these Kingdoms rose up against Us in open Rebellion, threatming the Sub-version of the Peace and Iranquility of Our Kingdoms; whereby it hath pleafed Him in His infinite Mercy not only to reflore to Us and Oir Kingdoms a perfect Prace, by an utter Diffipation of all thoje R b is, but likewije to delever into Our Hands the chief Heads of that Horrid Traiterous Confpiracy in order to their Condign Punifoment, that thereby nothing might remain to interrupt Our peaceable Government for the future Upon the due Con-fideration whereof. We do with all Humility Admire and Adore the late Mercy and Goodn fs of God in g ving Viltory to Our Arms, and delivering Us and Our Kingdoms from the Miseries and Galamities ibut might, and constantly do insue an Intestine and Unnatural Rebellion. And const dering that such signal and publick Mereics are Invitations from Heaven to Us and all Our Subjects to render the most publick and chearful Expressions of Thank fulness to the Divine Goodnels. We are wil ing that the Full Tribute of Praise and Ibanklgiving to Our Great Sove-raign the KING of Heaven and Earth, be folemnly returned by Us and all Our People for this His late Mercy. And to the end some solemn time may be appointed for the publick performance of this Duty, that all Our Sub-jects in England and Wales, and Toron of Berwick upon Tweed, who equally foare in the Bleffing and Foys of this Deliverance, may be united in the Devotions which are offered for it; We do bereby publish and declares, That Sunday the Twenty fixth Day of this Instant July he observed as a Day of Publick Thank sciping to Almighty God throughout Our Kingdom of Eugland, Dominion of Wales, and Town of Berwick upon Tweed, for this His great Mercy. And We do dired, and appoint that this Our Proclamation be publickly madin all Churches and Chercels on Hurden precedent Thirds to the confi and Chappels on Sunday precedent Thereto, to theread what notice be taken theread, and due Thunks and Praise may upon the faid Twony, fath Day of July be offered up unto Almighty God by Us and all Our Peaple withome Heart; And that humble Supplications be made before Wim for His continuer Affilance, and Phyrotement of Him for His continuer Affiliance, and Phyrotement of Hit and all His Mersies, to the Honour of His Rreat Wane, and the Safety, Peace and Renchs of His Rreat Wane, and the Safety, Peace and Renchs of His Kingdoms and Dominions : We willing and friftly com-manding all Perfors within these Oils Bobtinities with all Sobriety, Reverence and Thankfulness to perform this
