## PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS there was this day read at the Board an Order in Council, dated the fourth day of February last, whereby it was ordered, that notice should be given in the London Gazette, that after the expiration of one calendar month from the date of the publication of that Order and notice, Her Majesty, with the advice of Her Privy Council, would take into consideration the propriety of making the two several Orders therein specified, for the purposes of an Act, passed in the last session of Parliament, intituled "An " Act for the more easy recovery of small debts " and demands in England:"

And whereas notice of the said Order was given accordingly, and published in the London Gazette on Saturday the sixth day of February last:

Her Majesty, having taken the premises into consideration, is thereupon pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that, on the thirteenth day of March in this year, the several courts holden for the recovery of small debts or demands, under the provisions of any Act or Acts cited in one or both of the schedules annexed to the said Act of the last session of Parliament, and marked (A) and (B) respectively, shall be abolished, except a court

holden for the manor of Sheffield, under an Act, passed in the forty-eighth year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled " An Act for regulating the proceedings in the " Courts Baron of the manors of Sheffield and " Ecclesall, in the county of York;" and excepting also the courts hereinafter more particularly specified; and that, on and after the fifteenth day of March in this year, the County Court of Middlesex, heretofore holden under the provisions of an Act, passed in the twentythird year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, intituled "An Act " for preventing delays and expences in the " proceedings in the County Court of Middlesex, " and for the more easy and speedy recovery of " small debts in the said County Court," shall be holden under the provisions of the said Act of the last session of Parliament, in the several districts into which the said county shall be divided, by any Order to be made by Her Majesty, with the advice of Her Privy Council; and also that each of the several Courts of Request or Conscience heretofore holden for the recovery of debts and demands in the several cities, towns, and places hereinafter mentioned within the provisions of some one or more of the Acts cited in the schedule annexed to the said Act of the last session of Parliament, and marked (A), shall be holden as a County Court on and after the said fifteenth day of March, in the city or town hereinafter mentioned to
