

the duties upon other kinds of brandies imported into Sweden :

In pottles or jars, without reference to strength, per pot, 21½ skillings.

In other packages, of a strength not exceeding 88 per cent., per lb., 12½ skillings.

For every half per cent. strength above 88, $\frac{1}{10}$ skilling additional per lb.

The strength to be determined by the authorized hydrometer.

If the wares are mixed with sugar or other ingredients causing the hydrometer to indicate incorrectly, the duty is to be paid as on spirits of 100 per cent. strength.

Tare on casks weighing from 250 lbs. or more, allowance is to be given of 15 per cent ; on casks of less weight, 23 per cent.

The above resolution will come into force on the 1st February next, and remain in operation until the 1st April following.
