THE Board of Trade have received through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at Syra, stating that he had received information from the Nomarch of the Cyclades to the effect, that in consequence of cholera having made its appearance in towns on the Italian coast, the Hellenic Government has put arrivals from Barazza, Maneglia, Levanto, Sestri, and Spezzia in quarantine for eleven days (as infected with cholera), from the 1st ultimo, to be performed at the lazaretto at Delos, and those from Genoa on account of the communication with the said places, in quarantine of observation for five days from the same date, to be performed in all harbours where a health office of any class exists.

THE Board of Trade have received through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a Despatch from Her Majesty's Minister at Athens, stating that, by a Royal Ordinance, and on account of cholera having made its appearance in certain towns and villages on the Italian coast, arrivals in Greek ports from Genoa have been subjected to a quarantine of observation of five days, and those from Barazza, Maneglia, Levanto, and Spezzia to an effective quarantine of eleven days.
