Extract from Madrid Gazette, July 18, 1884.

In view of the excessive crowd of ships in the foul lazaret ports, and in order to harmonize the interests of the public health with those of commerce, you are instructed to make arrangements for the performance of their quarantine at the stations of observation in the ports of arrival by all vessels subject to three days' observation under existing regulations. Such suspected merchandize (see Article 41 of the Sanitary law) as may be landed from these vessels for introduction into your province, shall be submitted to cleansing (espurgo) and fumigation at the proper place, and in the proper manner.
