

From Colonel R. G. Kekewich to Major-General Walter Kitchener, &c., Commissioner for the Surrender of Arms, &c.

1. I beg to forward, herewith, particulars and numbers of surrenders, &c. Generals Liebenburg and Du Toit, made satisfactory arrangements and there was no hitch of any kind.

Both at Reitkuil on 7th June, and at Wolmaranstad on 10th June, all the burghers took the Oath of Allegiance most solemnly, and at the conclusion of the proceedings gave three very hearty cheers for the King.

Captain (local Major) Sir William Dick Cunyngham, 1st Scottish Horse, who commanded my escort, and Captain Carr, Worcestershire Regiment, my Assistant Provost-Marshal, rendered useful assistance in carrying out the details of the surrenders.

2. Captain de Vic Carey, Worcestershire Regiment, was directed by me to proceed to Potchefstroom, near which place on 9th June, he took the surrenders (amounting to 148) of the Gatsrand and Vaal River Wards of the Potchefstroom Commando under Commandant Redelinghuis.
