PROCLAMATION.

New South Wales to wit.  
(L.S.)

Harry H. Rawson,  
Governor.

By His Excellency Sir Harry Holdsworth Rawson, Vice-Admiral in the Royal Navy, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor of the State of New South Wales and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by section 154 of the "Stock Act, 1901," the Governor may, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, restrict or absolutely prohibit for any specified time the importation or introduction of any stock, fodder, or fittings from any other State or country in which there is reason to believe any infectious or contagious disease in stock exists: And whereas there is reason to believe that certain infectious and contagious diseases exist in some of the countries of Europe, Asia, Africa, America, and in Colonies other than the Australian States: Now, therefore, I, Sir Harry Holdsworth Rawson, the Governor aforesaid, do, by this my Proclamation, hereby restrict, as set forth in Schedule A hereto, and absolutely prohibit, as set forth in Schedule B hereto, for a period of two years from the date hereof, the importation or introduction into this State of the stock, fodder, and fittings mentioned in the said Schedules from the countries or Colonies therein named:—

SCHEDULE A.

The undermentioned Stock and Fittings may, if otherwise admissible, be introduced into this State in accordance with the Stock Act, 1901, and Regulations thereunder, from the Countries and Colonies, and shipped at the ports specified below:—

Deer, Antelopes, Llamas, Buffaloes, and other wild ruminants for a Zoological Society, may be admitted unless specially prohibited, and shall be dealt with, except as regards the place of quarantine, in all respects as other Stock.
