

uniform of Flag Officers, as regards the cuff the full dress coat:—

1. The "slash" to be of the present shape and size, but to consist of oak leaf embroidery without edging on a ground of white cloth (buttons to remain as at present), in place of the existing plain white cloth "slash" edged with gold lace.

2. A band of  $1\frac{1}{4}$  inch gold lace round the cuffs, with rows of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch distinction lace round the sleeve above the cuff, according to rank, to be substituted for oak leaf embroidery  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches round the cuff, with  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch distinction lace.

The space between each row of lace to be, as before,  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch.

Two years will be allowed before these alterations become compulsory.
