ARMY COUNCIL ORDER.

THE FORMALDEHYDE (DEALINGS) ORDER,
1918.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations,

the Army Council hereby order as follows :—

1. No person shall purchase, sell or make, or take delivery of or payment for any Formaldehyde (40 per cent. solution) at any price other than £150 per ton delivered free on rail; provided that upon any sale of any quantity exceeding ten gallons and not exceeding one barrel an addition of 7d. per lb. may be made; and provided that upon any sale of any quantity exceeding five gallons and not exceeding ten gallons an addition of 7½d. per lb. may be made; and provided that upon any sale of any quantity not exceeding five gallons an addition of 8d. per lb. may be made; and provided further that upon any sale of any quantity less than one barrel additional charges may be added to the sale price in respect of carriage and containers, such charges to be limited to any expenses actually incurred by the vendor, subject to an addition of 1d. per container in the case of containers holding less than one-half gallon.

2. This Order may be cited as the Formaldehyde (Dealings) Order, 1918.
