SILSDEN ELECTRICITY.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Silsden Urban District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") whose address is the Town Hall, Silsden, have applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To empower the Undertakers to supply electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 within the urban district of Silsden in the County of the West Riding of York.

2. To authorise the Undertakers to exercise within the area of supply all powers usually conferred upon distributors of electrical energy.

3. The streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority which the Undertakers propose to take special powers to break up are:—

Lee's Square, James Place, James Square, John's Square, Thanet's Square, Walker Place, Mill Banks, Albert Square, Sykes Lane, Elliott Street from Prince Street, to Back Oakland Street, Oakland Street, Back Oakland Street, Hawthorne Street, Back Hawthorne Street, Strawberry Street, Back Strawberry Street, Spring Gardens, Back Spring Gardens, Prince Street, Back Prince

Street, Back Street from Aire View School to King Street, King Street, Back King Street, Queen Street, Back Queen Street, Mitchell Square, South View Terrace, Back South View Terrace, Road from Skipton Road to Vicarage, East View, Back East View, West View, Back West View, Back Skipton Road West from Tufton Street to Barrett Street, Hothfield Street, Back Hothfield Street, Barrett Street, Back Barrett Street, Street between Back South View Terrace and Norton Street, Laurel Grove, Street between Laurel Grove and southern end of Elm Grove, Norton Street, Back Norton Street, Fairfax Street, Back Fairfax Street, Back Street connecting Fairfax Street and Norton Street, Elm Grove, Back Elm Grove, Street from Skipton Road to Farden Street, Tillotson Street, Back Tillotson Street, Farden Street, Back Farden Street, Clifford Street, Back Clifford Street, Back Skipton Road West from Clifford Street to Greengate, Hothfield Street North, Back Hothfield Street North, Tufton Street North, Back Tufton Street North, Greengate, Highfield Lane, Hayhills Road, Back Bridge Street, Road leading from Bridge Street to Sunny Bank, Chapel Lane, Back Browfield Terrace (North-West side), Back Browfield Terrace (South-East side), Eidsforth Terrace, Stirling Street, Town Head Lane, Dale View, Back Dale View, Bolton Terrace, Back Bolton Terrace, Back Oak View, Back Cragg View, Part of Street abutting on Nos. 38 and 40 Bolton Road, Wesley Place, Back Wesley Place, Mitchell Lane, Daisy Hill, Back Daisy Hill and Back Keighley Road.

4. The streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that distributing mains shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order are:—

Keighley Road from "Airedale Villa" to Elliott Street, Kirkgate, Bolton Road from Kirkgate to No. 101 Bolton Road, Elliott Street from Keighley Road to Prince Street, Prince Street, South View Terrace, Laurel Grove for a distance of one hundred and seven yards or thereabouts from South View Terrace, Street between Laurel Grove and southern end of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Skipton Road West from "The Gables" (formerly "Bleak House") to Skipton Road, and Skipton Road.

5. To make provision as to the maximum prices to be charged for electricity within the area of supply and to empower the Undertakers to supply electricity for purposes incidental to the working and lighting of any railway tramway or canal situate partly within and partly without the area of supply.

And notice is hereby also given that every local or other public authority, company or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, W.C., and despatched on or before the 26th day of May 1926 and a copy of such objection must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Solicitors or Parliamentary Agents.
