- (a) To cease on union with Bradford Christ Church taking effect, or upon the cesser of any pension which may be awarded to an Incumbent retiring in order to facilitate the union.
- (b) To cease on the 25th March, 1940.
- (c) To cease on the 25th March, 1941.
- (d) To cease on the 25th December, 1942.
- (e) To cease on the 25th March, 1943.
- (f) To cease on the 25th March, 1955.
- (g) To cease in the event of the Benefice being no longer held in plurality with Croxton.
- (h) To cease in the event of the Benefice being no longer held in plurality with Lower Gravenhurst.
- (i) To be subject to re-consideration on the Living becoming entitled to a certain legacy.
- (j) To cease on union with Lindsey.
- (k) To cease upon the charge prospectively created upon the revenues of the United Benefice of Orcheston St. George with Orcheston St. Mary becoming effective.
- (n) To be reduced to £17 p.a. on charge taking effect on revenues of prospective United Benefice of Willingale with Shellow.
- (o) To be reduced to £36 p.a. on charge taking effect on revenues of prospective United Benefice of Willingale with Shellow.
- (p) To cease upon a transfer—as defined in the Benefices Act, 1898—of the patronage.
- (q) To cease upon charge of £40 p.a. becoming payable out of revenues of Abbess with Beauchamp Roding United Benefice.
- (r) To cease upon union with Whaddon taking effect.
- (s) To cease upon union with Down Hatherley taking effect.
- (t) The grant will be subject to variation or withdrawal at the discretion of the Commissioners in the event of any powers of the Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, in relation to Union or otherwise, being exercised in a manner to affect this Benefice.
- (u) To cease on union with another Benefice.
- (v) To cease upon any augmentation taking effect out of revenues of proposed United Benefice of Wadingham with Snitterby.
- (w) To cease upon union with Ipswich St. Lawrence taking effect.
- (x) To cease when Benefice becomes entitled to a charge on another Benefice.
- (y) To cease upon augmentation by Ecclesiastical Commissioners out of improved income of Wilsford (to be appropriated by Ecclesiastical Commissioners) taking effect.
- (ac) To cease in the event of the Living being no longer held in plurality with Knapton.
- (ae) In lieu (ab initio) of grants of similar amount from the same dates made under previous rules.
- (af) To cease on the 23rd July, 1927.
- (ag) To cease in the event of the Living being no longer held in plurality with Eyworth.
- (ah) To cease on the union of the Living with Withersdale taking effect.
- (ai) To cease in the event of the Living being no longer held in plurality with Marton le Moor.
- (ak) To cease in the event of the Living being no longer held in plurality with Holmpton.
- (al) To cease on the 19th November, 1927.
