

application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875:—

(1) partially to repeal, alter or amend Part II of the Bradford Corporation (Various Powers) Act, 1887, so as to enable the Corporation to erect, construct, provide, maintain, furnish equip, regulate and manage Turkish Russian medicated and other baths the efficient properties of which are due to agencies other than water, and to demand and take such reasonable charges for the use thereof as they may think fit;

(2) partially to repeal alter or amend the Bradford Corporation Act, 1913, by substituting for sections 96 and 97 thereof (relating to fire insurance and accident funds) provisions enabling the Corporation to establish an insurance fund or insurance funds for making good losses, damages, costs and expenses to which the Corporation may be subjected in respect of risks in respect of all or any of the following matters, namely:—

- (a) fire;
- (b) accidents to or claims by third parties in respect of vehicles;
- (c) explosion of boilers;
- (d) under the common law; the Employers Liability Act, 1880, the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1925, or any Act or Acts repealed by or for the time being amending or extending those Acts or any of them or otherwise in respect of accidents to officers servants or workmen of the Corporation or to third parties;
- (e) injuries to school children;
- (f) mechanical or electrical breakdown at or in connexion with any of the undertakings of the Corporation;
- (g) loss due to infidelity or negligence of officers servants or workmen of the Corporation;
- (h) accident to any teacher employed in any public elementary school or any college secondary school institute or hostel not provided by the Corporation as the local education authority;
- (i) any other risks against which the Corporation would ordinarily insure;

(3) partially to repeal, alter or amend the Bradford Corporation Act, 1925, so as to provide for the abandonment of work No. 2 being one of the waterworks authorised by that Act and to enable the Corporation to construct and maintain in substitution therefor new works consisting of a catch-water and an aqueduct in tunnel in the parish or township of Stonebeck Up in the rural district of Pateley Bridge;

(4) partially to repeal, alter or amend Section 32 of the Bradford Waterworks and Improvement Act, 1885, so as to enable the Corporation to provide, erect, maintain, lease or let shops and other buildings and conveniences on the whole or any part of the disused burial ground situate in James Street, Bradford, and now used in part as a casual market;

(5) to empower the Corporation to borrow money for all or any of the purposes aforesaid;

(6) for the several purposes of the application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Acts, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said City as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that G. H. Thiselton-Dyer, Esq., M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Town Hall, Bradford, on Thursday, the seventh day of March, 1929, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given that plans showing the situation and line of the proposed new waterworks in the parish or township of Stonebeck Up referred to in paragraph (3) above have been deposited at the Town Hall, Bradford, and may be inspected on any week-day prior to the seventh day of March, 1929, during ordinary office hours;

And notice is hereby further given that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
