### PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 20th day of December, 1932 (G.H.), in the words following, viz.:—

"Whereas by section 20 of the Greenwich Hospital Act, 1865, it is enacted, inter alia, 65-33910

that the Admiralty shall from time to time continue or appoint such officers, clerks and servants for the purposes of the Hospital and Schools as seem fit, and may (subject to the approval of Your Majesty in Council) fix the salaries of such officers and clerks:

"And whereas by section 8 of the Greenwich Hospital Act, 1872, it is enacted that the provisions of section 20 of the Greenwich Hospital Act, 1865, so far as the same relate to salaries, shall extend to pensions and pecuniary benefits of any kind:

"And whereas Mr. H. Waite, a former Assistant Master in the Royal Hospital School, Greenwich, is eligible for the award of superannuation allowances from the funds of Greenwich Hospital in respect of his services at Greenwich from the 17th June, 1889, to the 28th February, 1894:

"And whereas Lieutenant Commander S. T. P. Yeo, on the Retired List of Your Majesty's Fleet, has performed the duties of Chief Officer of the Royal Hospital School, Greenwich, for over seven years and which post he will relinquish on the forthcoming removal of the School to Holbrook, Suffolk:

"And whereas we are of opinion that his meritorious service under the Department of Greenwich Hospital is deserving of special recognition:
