A PROCLAMATION

REVOKING, SO FAR AS IT RELATES TO OUR DOMINION OF NEW ZEALAND, THE PROCLAMATION OF THE 1ST AUGUST, 1896, APPLYING PARTS OF THE COINAGE ACT, 1870, TO THE COLONIES NOW FORMING THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA AND TO NEW ZEALAND.

Whereas by virtue of a Proclamation of Her Majesty Queen Victoria dated the 1st day of August, 1896, (hereinafter called "the Proclamation") certain parts of the Coinage Act, 1870, (in this Proclamation referred to as "the Act") as amended by section two and the schedule of the Coinage Act, 1891, were applied, with the modifications specified in the

Proclamation, to the Colonies of New South Wales, South Australia, Tasmania, Victoria, Queensland and Western Australia, and to New Zealand:

And whereas by virtue of the Act, it is lawful for Us, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to revoke any Proclamation previously made under the Act:

And whereas provision respecting the currency of Our Dominion of New Zealand is made by an Act of the Parliament of New Zealand entitled the Coinage Act 1933 and Our Ministers in Our Dominion of New Zealand have requested that the said Proclamation be revoked:

Now, therefore, We, with the advice of Our Privy Council in pursuance of the Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby proclaim, direct, and ordain, as follows:—

1. The Proclamation so far as relates to Our Dominion of New Zealand is hereby revoked and accordingly the Act shall cease to apply to and to be in force in New Zealand.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the New Zealand (Coinage) Proclamation 1934.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this ninth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and in the twenty-fifth year of Our Reign.
