WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section fifteen of the Herring Industry Act, 1935, that that Act shall not extend to Northern Ireland unless and until provision to that effect is made by an Order of His Majesty in Council made in pursuance of a resolution passed by both Houses of the Parliament of Northern Ireland:

And whereas such a resolution as is required by the said subsection has been passed by both Houses of the said Parliament:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the said resolution and by virtue of all powers enabling Him in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the Herring Industry Act, 1935, shall extend to Northern Ireland.
