HOLIDAYS WITH PAY ACT, 1938.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Labour, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the Holidays with Pay Act, 1938, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the Holidays with Pay (Adaptation of Enactments) (Trade Boards and Road Haulage) Regulations, 1938, applying, with modifications, certain provisions of the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, and the Road Haulage Wages Act, 1938, for the purposes of the Holidays with Pay Act, 1938, in addition to those expressly made applicable thereby.
