The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice, that on the 7th June, 1939, he made Regulations under the Factories Act, 1937, prescribing conditions subject to which the occupier of a factory in which the preserving or canning of fruit or vegetables is carried on, may avail himself of the special exception in Section 94 of the Act.

The Regulations may be cited as the Fruit and Vegetable Preserving (Hours of Women and Young Persons) Regulations, 1939, and will come into force on the 2nd July, 1939.
