LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

*River Trent Catchment Board.**Messingham Internal Drainage District.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the River Trent Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the constitution of the Messingham Internal Drainage District and of a drainage board therefor, the

abrogation of the powers of the Commissioners of Sewers for the County of Lincoln, City of Lincoln and County of the said City and part of the County of Nottingham, so far as such powers are exercisable within the proposed new district, and for certain matters supplemental thereto; and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty-one days from the date of this Notice a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament.

MONTGOMERY SWINE FEVER INFECTED AREA ORDER OF 1939.

SUBJECT.

Restricts as from the 24th July, 1939, the movement of swine into, out of, or within the county of Montgomery. Prohibits the holding of markets of swine within the county except as regards fat swine intended for immediate slaughter. Specifies conditions upon which licences for movements of swine may be granted.
