ROAD TRAFFIC.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him under Regulation 70 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, he has made The Borough of Kendal (Parking Place) Order, 1940. The Order provides that notwithstanding anything contained in the Order made by the Council of the Borough of Kendal under Section 68 of the Public Health Act, 1925, dated 26th July, 1927, no person shall use as a parking place for vehicles any part of Sandes Avenue, Kendal.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the River Trent Catchment Board have made application under sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, that the statutory map of the Catchment Area be varied so far as relates to the extent of the main river by the addition thereto of certain new bye-pass channels at Tamworth and the deletion therefrom of the previously existing watercourses and the forebay and tailbay of the millstream at Alders Mill.

Maps on the 6-inch scale on which the proposed additions are shown by lines in red colour and the proposed deletions by lines in green colour, may be inspected, together with a copy of the statutory map of the Catchment Area, at the Southern Division Office of the River Trent Catchment Board, 35, Market Street, Tamworth, or at the offices of the Ministry.

Any objection to the proposed variation of the statutory map shall be made in writing and sent by post, addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, at the address mentioned below, within thirty-one days from the date of this notice.
