The KING has been pleased, by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Realm, bearing date the 7th instant, to confer the honour of Knighthood upon the undermentioned gentlemen:—

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The Secretary of State for the Home Department gives notice that on the 1st instant, in pursuance of Section 6 of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act, 1928, as applied by the Petroleum (Compressed Gases) Order, 1930, he made the Gas Cylinders (Conveyance) Provisional Regulations, 1942, which amend the Gas Cylinders (Conveyance) Regulations, 1931, by substituting the words "1,980 lbs." for the words "1,800 lbs." in Regulation 5 of those Regulations.
