One night in July, 1943, the bomb load of an aircraft, which was standing in the dispersal area, detonated and the wreckage caught fire. Soon a second aircraft caught fire and its bomb load also exploded.

Flying Officer Doehler was proceeding to the scene immediately after the first aircraft had exploded, when the second aircraft blew up and he was thrown to the ground. He immediately got up and went towards an aircraft which had not caught fire and taxied it to safety.

Assistance to injured personnel was rendered by Flight Lieutenant McCombe, an armament officer, who had, on a previous occasion, displayed great calmness in directing fire fighting operations on an aircraft which was blazing near to a 4,000 lb. bomb and by Flight Lieutenant Lindsay, a medical officer, who had previously displayed great courage in dragging the body of an air gunner from a blazing turret. Flight Lieutenants McCombe and Lindsay proceeded to the first aircraft after it had exploded and found that several airmen, who had been standing under the wing, had been seriously injured and burned. During their successful efforts in rescuing two airmen, both officers were thrown to the ground by an explosion in the second aircraft. Flight Lieutenant Lindsay then took the rescued airmen to

hospital, while his companion remained and took the remaining injured personnel into his own car. While the car was being drawn away a bomb exploded and two large fragments were hurled through the doors of the car. Flight Lieutenant McCombe remained unperturbed only thinking of the safety of those he had rescued.

Sergeant Campbell was proceeding to the scene of the first explosion when the second aircraft blew up and he was thrown to the ground. Undaunted, he went on and helped to start the engines of a nearby bomber which had not been caught by the flames and while this aircraft was being taxied away he went to a second aircraft and after its engines had been started assisted the pilot in negotiating obstructions while the aircraft was being taxied to safety. During this time an explosion occurred and Sergeant Campbell was knocked down again. Still undeterred, he helped to put out fires on the runway.

Leading Aircraftman Snelling was thrown to the ground by the explosion in the second aircraft while he was proceeding to render assistance at the first aircraft when it had blown up. Regaining his feet he ran to an aircraft which was untouched by fire and taxied it away after having started its engines himself.

Leading Aircraftman Wilkinson proceeded to the scene when he heard the first explosion and helped a wounded man to safety. The fire had spread to the second aircraft and, disdaining the risk of explosion of its bombs, this airman led 3 other men to rescue another injured man lying near the first aircraft. As the party were leading the rescued man away from the conflagration the second aircraft exploded and all were thrown to the ground but they were able to save their comrade and reached safety as a third explosion occurred.

Awarded the George Medal

Acting Squadron Leader Peter Guy OTTEWILL
(46451), Royal Air Force.

One day in June, 1943, a Beaufighter aircraft crashed into an ammunition store when taking off and immediately caught fire. Both occupants of the aircraft were stunned and unable to get out unaided. Despite the bursting of the aircraft's war load of ammunition (which included cannon shells), the 30,000 rounds of ammunition which were exploding in the store and the grave danger of the petrol tanks exploding, Squadron Leader Ottewill, accompanied by 2 others, went to the scene of the accident in an endeavour to rescue the crew. Squadron Leader Ottewill, ignoring a burning petrol tank, jumped on to the wing and after opening the front hatch, he succeeded in releasing the pilot and dragged him clear. Squadron Leader Ottewill then returned and rescued the observer who was in

a very dazed condition and oblivious to what had happened. Shortly afterwards a petrol tank exploded. Squadron Leader Ottewill, who had been severely burned on a previous occasion when his own aircraft was shot down by the enemy, accepted the risk of further severe burns, and injury in going to the assistance of his comrades and effecting their rescue. Fortunately he sustained only slight burns during this rescue.

635541 Sergeant Gildus DAVIES, Royal Air Force.

In June, 1943, Sergeant Davies was the 2nd engineer in an aircraft which crashed into high ground and immediately caught fire. Sergeant Davies, displaying complete disregard for his own safety, made many attempts to open a hatch and eventually succeeded in releasing one of his trapped comrades whom he dragged to safety. Sergeant Davies then attempted to re-enter the blazing aircraft in an endeavour to rescue other members of the crew. He was, however, compelled to abandon the attempt owing to the intense heat which exploded depth charges in the aircraft. This airman displayed outstanding courage and devotion to duty.

1412165 Aircraftman 1st Class Daniel OWEN, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

In July, 1943, Aircraftman Owen was working in a bomb dump with 6 other airmen. He was engaged in attaching trolleys of bombs behind a tractor when a 1,000 lb. bomb in the dump exploded, killing 5 of the party and setting fire to a tractor and a portable crane. Aircraftman Owen, who was only a few yards from the airmen who had been killed, was badly shaken but, ignoring the danger of further explosions, he immediately attempted to rescue another airman who was lying under a fiercely blazing vehicle. Although his comrade died as a result of injuries he succeeded in dragging him clear of the vehicle. Still disregarding his own safety Aircraftman Owen then drove a tractor and towed 3 loaded bomb trolleys away from the burning wreckage. This action probably saved further damage and injuries to personnel. Aircraftman Owen's prompt and gallant conduct was a fine example of devotion to duty.

1436050 Flight Sergeant Harry Ernest HALL, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

One night in August, 1943, Flight Sergeant Hall was pilot of an aircraft which was returning from operations. When approaching the South Coast of England the aircraft ran out of fuel and dived almost out of control into the sea. The crew were temporarily knocked out by the impact and the aircraft filled rapidly with water. Flight Sergeant Hall was the first to recover and his first thoughts were for the safety of his crew. He found the wireless operator injured and floating just below the astro-dome, and in spite of the rapidly rising water and with complete disregard for his own safety, he succeeded in extricating him from the aircraft and securing him safely in a dinghy. He then returned to the aircraft to search for the navigator and flight engineer who were missing. Five members of the crew were subsequently picked up by an air/sea rescue launch. In a desperate situation, aggravated by darkness, Flight Sergeant Hall displayed extreme courage and coolness throughout.

516813 Sergeant Roland Walton COULSTON, Royal Air Force.

One night in June, 1943, one of a number of aircraft which had been loaded with bombs in readiness for an operation, caught fire. The bombs on board exploded and flaming masses of debris were hurled in all directions setting fire to 2 other aircraft and much of the dry grass in the vicinity. Flight Sergeants McDonald and Neilsen, a pilot and an air gunner, respectively, immediately ran to a bomber which was almost surrounded by burning scrub and, after starting the engines, taxied it to safety. Sergeant Coulston, a pilot, rushed to a bomber which was standing by the 2 which had caught fire, and although fully aware that the 2 burning bombers were likely to explode, proceeded to start its engines, thereby enabling the aircraft to be taxied away to safety. Flight Sergeants McDonald, and Neilsen and

Sergeant Coulston displayed courage and complete disregard for their personal safety and undoubtedly saved several valuable aircraft from destruction.

1394967 Sergeant Harold John RHODA, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

In June, 1943, Sergeant Rhoda was the wireless operator-air gunner in an aircraft which was forced down into the sea. This airman managed to extricate himself from the almost submerged aircraft but, realising that some members of the crew were missing, re-entered the aircraft and successfully extricated the 2nd pilot who was unconscious and trapped. Sergeant Rhoda, being uncertain whether the navigator had escaped, then searched the fuselage but was unable to locate him. Throughout, Sergeant Rhoda displayed high courage and undoubtedly saved the 2nd pilot's life.

650030 Sergeant Norman Andrew WORKMAN, Royal Air Force.

On 5th June, 1943, Sergeant Workman was a member of the crew of an aircraft which crashed when alighting on the sea. The flying boat, which was about half mile from the flare path burst into flames. Although suffering from burns, bruises, cuts and shock, Sergeant Workman, disregarding his own safety, managed to lift one member of the crew into a gun position and to help another to a float. When the flames prevented him from rendering further assistance, Sergeant Workman made his way to shore in an endeavour to secure help. The half-mile journey involved wading through water waist deep, whilst hampered by weeds and mud. This airman displayed great determination and fortitude in his efforts to assist his companions but unfortunately Sergeant Workman was the only survivor.

1291419 Leading Aircraftman Harry Thomas COLLINS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

One morning in July, 1943, while a petrol bowser was being re-fuelled, the pumping motor backfired and started a fire in the bowser, which contained about 850 gallons of 100 octane fuel and which was surrounded by a large number of 40 gallon drums filled with petrol. The bowser burned fiercely and showed signs of exploding and igniting the entire fuel dump. Leading Aircraftman Collins ran to the scene and assisted in rolling the nearest drums to a safe distance. Then, despite the great heat, he crawled under the lorry where the rear tyres were burning, unhooked the towing bar and then drove the lorry away. In so doing Leading Aircraftman Collins prevented the conflagration from spreading to the main fuel dump and saved the lorry from destruction. He displayed great gallantry and a complete disregard of his own safety.

1028731 Leading Aircraftman George Roper THOMPSON, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

In August, 1943, this airman was working in an aircraft which had been fuelled and loaded with depth charges. An explosion occurred which set fire to the starboard side of the fuselage. Leading Aircraftman Thompson immediately left the aircraft and, having procured a fire extinguisher, re-entered it and succeeded in quelling the flames. This airman's prompt and gallant action in returning to the aircraft, knowing that it was loaded with high explosives, is worthy of high praise. He saved a valuable aircraft and averted serious damage to others which would have occurred had the fire caused the detonation of the explosives.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Wing Commander George Francis GRANT, D.F.C. (42216), Royal Air Force, No. 156 Squadron.

Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross this officer has undertaken many sorties, covering a wide range of targets. His unswerving devotion to duty, fortitude and tenacity were amply demonstrated on one occasion when he attacked Bochum in the face of difficult circumstances. Wing Commander Grant is an outstanding leader whose fine qualities have impressed all.

Acting Wing Commander Hubert LAW-WRIGHT, D.F.C. (79741), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 14 Squadron.

This officer has completed very many sorties and has displayed exceptional skill and tenacity. On a recent occasion he undertook an operation which entailed a flight lasting for 10½ hours. His efforts throughout and the result achieved were worthy of the highest praise. Wing Commander Law-Wright is a resolute leader, whose personal example has proved most inspiring.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flight Lieutenant Rodney Thirsk PHIPPS (Can/J.9648), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 272 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in very many sorties, involving successful attacks on shipping, airfields and rail installations. In September, 1943, Flight Lieutenant Phipps participated in an engagement against 11 Junkers 52. Early in the fight, a bullet pierced his windscreen. The gun sight was damaged and Flight Lieutenant Phipps was cut over the eye by splinters. Despite these difficulties, he fought with rare skill and destroyed 4 of the enemy aircraft. His fine qualities have earned great praise.

Flying Officer George Augustus Shotan WILLIAMS (118639), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 196 Squadron.

As navigator, Flying Officer Williams has taken part in many attacks against well defended targets in the Ruhr and Western Germany. He has displayed outstanding ability and great determination and has contributed materially to the successes obtained. His keenness and devotion to duty have always been evident.

Pilot Officer Philip DYSON (147748), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 196 Squadron.

Throughout his tour of operations, this officer has displayed great skill and sound judgment and has achieved much success. He has attacked his targets fearlessly, often in the face of heavy opposition, setting a very fine example.

Pilot Officer Cyril Bruce MEGONE (148126), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 603 Squadron.

Pilot Officer Megone is a keen and tenacious pilot. He has participated in a very large number of sorties, including a most determined attack on a large merchant ship which he bombed with destructive effect. In September, 1943, he took part in an engagement against a formation of enemy aircraft, one of which he shot down. During the combat, his aircraft was hit and a fire commenced near the port main plane. Nevertheless, Pilot Officer Megone coolly flew the aircraft to the flat terrain of a small island where he effected a safe landing. Flames were still issuing from one of the fuel tanks but they were quickly extinguished. The situation was serious but, as it was clear that the island was still in enemy hands, Pilot Officer Megone took off. Displaying great skill and resolution he succeeded, after a long flight, in reaching base where he landed his badly damaged aircraft safely. His courage and resource were of a high order.

Acting Warrant Officer George Alexander LINDSAY (Can/R.79665), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 156 Squadron.

This warrant officer was the mid-upper gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack Oldenburg one night in September, 1943. Shortly after the take-off, Warrant Officer Lindsay discovered that his electrically heated clothing was unserviceable and that his oxygen supply was not functioning properly. Displaying exceptional devotion to duty, Warrant Officer Lindsay refrained from disclosing these mishaps to his captain. At great personal discomfort, he remained at his post, alert to any threat to his aircraft, until the operation was almost completed. Not until the English coast was crossed, on the homeward flight, did he disclose his plight. His conduct was typical of the determination he has shown throughout the many sorties in which he has taken part.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flying Officer Eric Leeming HARTLEY (136223), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 58 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1281039 Flight Sergeant Kenneth Edward LADDS Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 58 Squadron.

This officer and airman were pilot and mid-upper gunner respectively of an aircraft engaged on a patrol in September, 1943. A surfaced U-boat was sighted and Flying Officer Hartley immediately dived to attack. In spite of fierce gun fire from the submarine, Flying Officer Hartley straddled the vessel with his depth charges and probably destroyed it. During the approach, Flight Sergeant Ladds used his guns to good effect, pouring a hail of bullets into the U-boats gun positions. The aircraft sustained severe damage during the action and, a little later, Flying Officer Hartley was compelled to bring it down on to the sea. This officer and airman together with other members of the crew boarded the dinghy in which they subsequently drifted for 11 days before being rescued. During this period they had little food or water and, at times the sea was very rough. Nevertheless, they bore their privations with great heart and fortitude, setting an example which proved an inspiration to their comrades.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

577497 Flight Sergeant John Charles CHAPMAN, Royal Air Force, No. 156 Squadron.

As flight engineer, this airman has participated in very many sorties, including attacks against such targets as Berlin, Peenemunde, Hamburg and Mannheim. He is a highly skilled and resolute member of aircraft crew, whose services have proved extremely valuable. His keenness and devotion to duty have been highly commendable.

1301824 Flight Sergeant Gordon George FORBES, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 156 Squadron.

As air gunner, Flight Sergeant Forbes has taken part in a large number of sorties and has displayed great determination and devotion to duty throughout. On one occasion, en route to Munster, Flight Sergeant Forbes was wounded in an encounter with an enemy fighter. Nevertheless, he fought with great resolution and refused to leave his post until the target had been bombed. His keenness and fine fighting spirit have been highly commendable.
