WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1945.

HAIR, BASS AND FIBRE WAGES COUNCIL
(GREAT BRITAIN).

The Hair, Bass and Fibre Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for (1) the revocation of the Hair, Bass and Fibre Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation Order, 1945 (S.R. & O. 1945, No. 980) and for the fixing of specified statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for the minimum rates of wages at present in operation and (2) for the amendment of Order H.B.(21) dated 19th May, 1939, which deals with holidays with pay.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within fourteen days from 18th June, 1946.
