## LONDON PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT, 1933

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made "The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 13) Regulations, 1951" (S.I. 1951 No. 1220), coming into operation on the 26th day of July, 1951, which makes permanent the one-way traffic working in various streets in the Metropolitan Borough of Bermondsey as set out in the Schedule hereto.

<i>Streets or Lengths of Street</i>	<i>Direction</i>
Brunel Road, between its junction with Lower Road and its junction with Rupack Street.	From south-west to north-east.
Albion Street, between its junction with Lower Road and its junction with Neptune Street.	From north-east to south-west.
Lower Road, between its junction with St. Marychurch Street and its junction with Brunel Road.	From north-west to south-east.
The slip road between the two small island sites situate immediately to the east of Lower Road near the junction of Lower Road with Brunel Road.	From north-east to south-west.
The slip road between the easternmost of the said two small island sites and the large triangular island site, situate to the north-west of Albion Street.	From north-east to south-west.
The slip road between the said large triangular island site and the Norwegian Church.	From south-east to north-west.

## LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

## Yorkshire Ouse River Board.

## LOWER OUSE INTERNAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, as applied by the River Boards Act, 1948, confirming with certain modifications, a Scheme submitted to him by the River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board (now superseded by the Yorkshire Ouse River Board) under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the following matters:—

(1) The constitution of a new internal drainage district to be known as the Lower Ouse Internal Drainage District.

(2) The constitution of a Drainage Board for the said Internal Drainage District

(3) The abolition of the following Drainage Boards: Bishopsoil Internal Drainage Board; Bellasize Drainage Board; Greenoak Drainage Board; Howden Drainage Board; Kilpin Internal Drainage Board; Barmby on the Marsh Internal Drainage Board and East Derwent Internal Drainage Board.

(4) Matters supplemental to or consequential upon the above.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty-five days from the date of this Notice a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.
