DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1951.

WITHDRAWAL OF AUTHORISATION.

(Thomas Leven.)

Whereas Thomas Leven, L.R.C.P., L.R.C.S., L.R.F.P.S., whose registered address is 2, Beech Avenue, Irvine, Ayrshire, has been convicted of offences against the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1951:
