UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT, 1923

ARCHITECTS REGISTRATION COUNCIL OF THE UNITED KINGDOM

Regulations made in pursuance of section 13 of the Architects (Registration) Act. 1931, amending the Existing Regulations.

Schedule 2

Examinations recognised by the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Architectural Education in accordance with section 6 (3) of the principal Act.

With effect from the 1st June 1961, amend Schedule 2 of the Regulations by the addition:

(1) of the words "The Department of Architecture, University of Edinburgh, the Degree of Bachelor of Architecture with Honours of the University of Edinburgh, followed by the examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience";

Professional Practice and Practical Experience";

(2) of the words "The Department of Architecture, University of Hong Kong, the Degree of Bachelor of Architecture of the University of Hong Kong, followed by the passing of the examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience of any one of the Schools of Architecture in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland which is recognised in respect of section 6 (i) (c) of the Principal Act, or of any examination in Professional Practice and Practical Experience which the Council may from time to time recognise for the purpose."

ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT, 1931
