WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 3) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of April 1963, the Worcester City Council made an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

- (1) to amend the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 2) Order 1952 by the deletion therefrom of Item 2 of the First Schedule thereto and Item 2 of the Second Schedule thereto;
- (2) to restrict the waiting of vehicles to 45 minutes in any period of two hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on weekdays in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto;
- (3) to prohibit at all times the waiting of vehicles
 - (a) on the south side of Pierpoint Street and
 - (b) on the north side of Pierpoint Street from its junction with Foregate Street to a point 45 feet east of that junction and from its junction with Sansome Walk to a point 45 feet east of that junction;
- (4) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on weekdays on the north side of Broad Street between its junction with Dolday and its junction with Blackfriars.

Exceptions are made for the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading, funerals and certain other essential services.

WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 2) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of April 1963 the Worcester City Council made an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960, the effect of which is:

- (1) to amend the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order, 1948 as amended by the City of Worcester (Traffic Regulation) (No. 2) Order 1952, by the deletion therefrom of Article 2 of the Second Schedule;
- (2) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on weekdays in either length of road specified in the first column of the first schedule hereto
 - (a) on the side thereof specified opposite thereto in the second column of the said schedule on those days of the month which bear even numbers;
 - (b) on the side thereof specified opposite thereto in the third column of the said schedule on those days of the month which bear odd numbers;
 - (c) for a longer period than 45 minutes in any period of two hours;
- (3) to prohibit at all times the waiting of vehicles on any length or part of a road specified in the second schedule hereto.

Exceptions are made for the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading, unloading, funerals and certain other essential services.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the City of Worcester where waiting is prohibited at all times

1. High Street, from its junction with Bank Street to a point 90 feet south of that junction and from its junction with Copenhagen Street to a point 30 feet north of that junction.
2. St. Swithun's Street, from its junction with The Cross to a point 45 feet east of that junction and from its junction with Trinity Street to a point 30 feet west of that junction.
