NEW TOWNS ACT 1965

Order under section 1

The Peterborough New Town (Designation) Order 1967

1. Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the New Towns Act 1965, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, on the 21st day of July 1967 made an Order designating as the site of a proposed new town an area amounting to approximately 15,940 acres of land in the administrative county of Huntingdon and Peterborough, comprising part of the borough of Peterborough, part of the urban district of Old Fletton, part of the rural district of Peterborough, part of the rural district of Norman Cross and part of the rural district of Thorney, which land is shown on the map referred to in the Order.
