#### PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

#### REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

##### *Hours and Overtime in the London Clearing Banks*

1. On 28th November 1969, in pursuance of her powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination the award dated 19th September 1969

of the Arbitration Tribunal set up in accordance with the constitution and rules of the Joint Negotiating Council for Banking providing, amongst other things, with effect from 1st July 1969, that staff in the London Clearing Banks, other than of Managerial status, shall be entitled to payment of overtime in respect of work carried out in excess of seven hours per working day.

2. The Board has now made its report entitled "Hours and Overtime in the London Clearing Banks". In accordance with section 5 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity hereby gives notice that the report was first published as Command Paper Number 4301 on 27th February 1970.
