The Caersws-Machynlleth Trunk Road (Felin-Gerig near Machynlleth) Order, 1970, and the Caersws-Machynlleth Trunk Road (Felin-Gerig, near Machynlleth Side Roads) Order, 197 .

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:—

- an Order under section 7 of the above Act providing
 - that a road which he proposes to construct at Felin-Gerig in the county of Montgomery shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
 - that the length of the Caersws-Machynlleth Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Secretary of State to the County Council of Montgomery (who will become the Highway Authority responsible for that length) that the new trunk road is opened for through traffic; and
- an Order under section 9 of the above Act authorising the Secretary of State
 - to stop up highways;
 - to construct a new highway to connect the unclassified road to Caerllof with the above mentioned Trunk Road, and
