HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Felin-y-Mor Road, Aberystwyth Side Road) Order 1972.

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Trefechan Railway Bridge, Aberystwyth in the County of Cardigan, made under section 9 of the above Act an Order which will authorise the Secretary of State to carry out improvements to Felin-y-Mor Road, Aberystwyth aforesaid.
