HIGHWAYS ACTS, 1959 to 1971

The M.A. Motorway (Pencoed to Stormy Down Section) Scheme, 197

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make a Scheme under section 11 of the Highways Act, 1959, authorising him to provide

for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act, 1959 (as amended) a special road about 12.53 kilometres in length from Pencoed in the County of Glamorgan to Stormy Down in the said County, and providing for the special road to become a trunk road on the date when the Scheme comes into operation.
