Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (2) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Health Department, Bentley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 26th May 1972.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Department of the Environment, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

Smoke Control Order, 1972*

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any date after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st July 1973.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1973, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Darlington, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 5th June 1972.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
