The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 7th March 1974, is to vary the Trunk Roads (Various Roads, Newark-on-Trent) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1972, so that waiting is now prohibited at any time on the north-western side of the A-46 trunk road known as Victoria Street, in the Borough of Newark-on-Trent, which extends from a point 50 yards south-west of its junction with Pelham Street to that junction.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the 1st March 1974 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
