DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT

THE FACTORIES (CLEANLINESS OF WALLS AND CEILINGS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1974

The Secretary of State for Employment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 (5) of the Factories Act 1961, made, on 14th March 1974 an Order amending Article 6 (2) of the Factories (Cleanliness of Walls and Ceilings) Order 1960.

Article 6 (2) provides that in the case of any factory as respects which certain provisions of (now) the Factories Act 1961 are enforceable by a district council the reference in Article 6 (1) to the inspector for the district shall be construed as a reference to the medical officer of health of that council. This Order amends Article 6 (2) by substituting for the reference to the medical officer of health a reference to an officer appointed for the purpose by the council.
