PRESENT,

THE QUEEN'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL

Whereas it is expedient to provide for revised rates and conditions of award of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities for Officers, Petty Officers, Non-Commissioned Officers and Men of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, for Officers and Ratings of the Women's Royal Naval Service and for Members of Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pensions) (No. 1) Order 1974.

2. The provisions contained in this Order shall have the effect from 1st April 1972.

3. The revised rates and conditions of award of retired pay, pensions, terminal grants and gratuities in respect of service in the Royal Navy, Royal Marines, Women's Royal Naval Service and Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service shall be as specified in the Schedules annexed hereto.

SCHEDULE I

SECTION I

General-Officers

1. The definitions and general conditions in this Section shall apply for the purpose of determining entitlement to retired pay, terminal grants and gratuities to Officers of Her Majesty's Royal Navy and Royal Marines, Women's Royal Naval Service and Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service.
