THE HEALTH AND SAFETY INQUIRIES (PROCEDURE) REGULATIONS 1975

The Secretary of State for Employment hereby gives notice that on 7th March 1975, he made the Health and Safety Inquiries (Procedure) Regulations 1975, coming into opera-

tion on 1st May 1975, under the powers conferred on him by sections 14 (3) and (4) and 82 (3) (a) of the Health and Safety at Work Etc. Act 1974, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf.

Section 14 of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974, gives powers to the Health and Safety Commission, with the consent of the Secretary of State, and to the Agriculture Ministers, to direct an inquiry to be held into any accident, occurrence, situation or other matter whatsoever which the Commission or Minister thinks it necessary or expedient to investigate for any of the general purposes of Part I of that Act or with a view to the making of regulations for those purposes.

These regulations prescribe the procedure to be followed at or in connection with such inquiries and the powers of the persons appointed to hold such inquiries.
