OFFSHORE PETROLEUM DEVELOPMENT  
(SCOTLAND) ACT 1975

*Designated Sea Area—Inner Sound of Raasay*

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice, That in terms of section 3 of and Schedule 3 to the Offshore Petroleum Development (Scotland) Act 1975 he has decided to make a sea designation Order providing for the making of a designated sea area in the Inner Sound of Raasay, all of Loch Carron and Loch Kishorn, part of Loch Alsh and part of Kyle Rhea. The designated sea area extends throughout the Inner Sound of Raasay to a line between the northern tip of the Island of Rona (NG 630 617) and Rubha na Fearn (NG 720 615). The western boundary extends southwards along the eastern coast of the Islands of Rona and Raasay to Eyre Point (NG 580 341), south-east to the Island of Scalpay (NG 589 331) and along its eastern coast to Rubha Aosail Sligneach (NG 601 274). Thence, the boundary runs southwards to the Isle of Skye (NG 598 270) and in a generally eastward direction along its coast into Kyle Rhea, where the southern boundary is a line from a point approximately half a mile south of the ferry jetty near the village of Kylerhea (NG 790 210) to a point approximately one mile south of the mainland ferry jetty (NG 795 210). The boundary extends as far east in Loch Alsh as a line from a point on the coast south of Ard Hill (NG 819 263) to Ardintoul Point (NG 833 245), then runs northwards along the coast, including Loch Carron and Loch Kishorn, to Rubha na Fearn (NG 720 615).

The purpose of the designation is to enable the Secretary of State to facilitate or control the execution of operations relating to the exploration for and exploitation of offshore petroleum.
