HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 to 1971

*The Chester-Bangor Trunk Road
(Sandy Lane, Saltney Detrunking) Order 1977*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 providing that a length of the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road known as Sandy Lane and situated at Saltney in the County of Clwyd ceased to be a trunk road as from the date when the Order came into operation.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff and at the offices of Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd and Alyn and Deeside District Council, Council Offices, Glynne Way, Hawarden, Clwyd where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts,

or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 27th October 1977, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
