

17. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of March, Saint Wendreda, in the diocese of Ely, for any ecclesiastical purpose affecting the parish or any part thereof, and vesting the said land in the Ely Diocesan Board of Finance Limited.

18. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Bedminster, in the diocese of Bristol, as an addition to the parsonage land of the benefice of Saint Michael and All Angels, Bedminster and vesting the said land in the incumbent of the said benefice for such use.

19. Uniting the benefices and parishes of Aston Cantlow ; and Wilmcote with Billesley, in the diocese of Coventry.

20. Vesting part of the churchyard of the parish church of the parish of East Ham with Saint Alban, Upton Park, in the diocese of Chelmsford, in the Chelmsford Diocesan Board of Finance Limited, for disposal.

21. Uniting the benefices of Barnham and Eastergate, in the diocese of Chichester.

22. Declaring redundant part of the parish church of the parish of Ealing Saint Mary, in the diocese of London, and appropriating it to use for any ecclesiastical purpose affecting the said parish.

23. Uniting the benefices of Brighstone ; and Brooke with Mottistone, in the diocese of Portsmouth.

24.—(1) Partially revoking an earlier scheme which provided for the redundancy of the church of Saint Catharine, Feltham, in the diocese of London,

(2) Appropriating the tower and spire of the said church, the site of the demolished part of the building and the land annexed or belonging thereto to use as offices and for purposes ancillary thereto, and

(2) Declaring redundant the parish church of the parish of Brightside,

(3) Uniting the new benefice and parish with the benefice and parish of Saint Thomas, Wincobank, and

(4) Altering the areas of the parishes of Brightside ; All Saints, Brightside ; Saint Cuthbert, Sheffield ; Saint Thomas, Wincobank ; and Saint Thomas, Kimberworth, in the diocese of Sheffield.

33. Declaring redundant the parish church of the parish of Kirk Sandall and altering the name of the benefice and parish of Kirk Sandall, in the diocese of Sheffield.

34. Creating a new benefice and parish of Saint John, Top 'o th' Moss, Bolton, in the diocese of Manchester, from parts of the Moss, Bolton, in the diocese of Manchester, from parts of the parishes of Saint James, Brightmet, Bolton and Lever Bridge.

35. Dissolving the benefices of Baldock with Bygrave and Clothall ; and Sandon and Wallington with Rushden ; and creating new benefices of Baldock with Bygrave ; and Sandon, Wallington and Rushden with Clothall, in the diocese of Saint Albans.
