Greeting!

Whereas by Warrant under Our Royal Sign Manual bearing date the twenty-third day of August 1974 Commissioners were appointed to inquire into, and report on, such matters concerning the distribution of personal incomes

both earned and unearned, and wealth, as might be referred to the Commission by the Government:

And whereas it has been represented to Us that there is no continuing need for a standing commission to consider

third day of August 1974:

Now therefore We do by these Presents will and ordain that Our said Warrant dated the twenty-third day of August 1974 shall cease to have effect on and from the first day of August 1979.
